

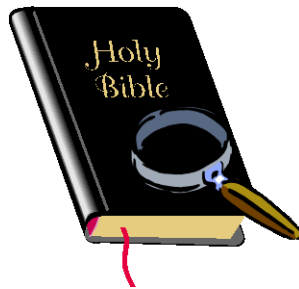
Discipleship Sunday School Class Room Number 7

Old Testament “Fable”: Speaking Truth To and From Power

Most of us consider fables as children’s stories only. However, fables were also ancient tales for adults that featured plants, animals, and even persons. Called mashal in Modern Hebrew (the same Old Testament word used for “parable”), a fable was used to deliver powerful turning-point messages whose locate them in Scripture; determine if they’re as easy as they sound within their setting; uncover why this unlikely art form was chosen; and share ideas about the spiritual applications of these special lessons to our lives.

The Wesley International class uses Cokesbury’s The United Methodist Adult Bible Studies “The New International Lesson” Old Testament and New Testament studies. Adults move from a focus on the Word to reflection on personal, family, church, and community concerns.

Fellowship Class Room 10

The Fellowship class uses a devotional format with lessons based on liturgical reading and on application of God’s word to our daily lives and experiences. Though the structure is a lecture format, input is welcome from all class participants and robust dialog is encouraged. The class sets a consensus driven subject selection which may involve the readings and discussion of popular books such as “The Shack”, “Ninety Minutes in Heaven,” “The Purpose Driven Life” or the sharing of thoughts and views on current events in our larger society or in the local community. The class leaders always make the effort to tie the scriptural reading to the subject matter, and they stress how we can benefit from God’s word in our daily faith journey.

Come join us! This class can be serious, it can be funny, it can be personal, insightful, challenging, and comforting – but it is mostly about Christian Fellowship with broad acceptance of our Brothers and Sisters in the Church Family.

Children Sunday School Classes

Preschool – Room 102

Up to age 4
